

Information for Customers of non-European Howmet Aerospace legal entities

Dear Valued Customer of a Howmet Aerospace non-European legal entity:

We are committed to product safety and to providing the information our customers need to comply with their REACH⁽¹⁾ obligations. Howmet Aerospace has established a dedicated Chemical Compliance Team that anticipates and manages potential impacts of REACH and other chemical regulations to our product portfolio, both inside and outside of the European Economic Area.

Registration:

Please note that many of our products (e.g., fasteners, turbine vanes, building panels, coils, plate, sheet and foil, rod) are considered as articles under REACH. Therefore, when imported into the European Economic Area, substances in them are not subject to registration.

Safety Data Sheets (SDSs)

Please note that most of Howmet Aerospace products do not require an SDS as per Article 31 of REACH. Howmet Aerospace is providing these SDSs voluntarily.

Candidate list

Howmet Aerospace is monitoring the substances on the candidate list, which is being modified twice a year, and their presence in our products. Information on presence of a substance of the candidate list > 0.1 % of weight in our products is available through your standard Howmet Aerospace commercial contact or, for Howmet Fastening Systems, in our webpage www.howmet.com.

Our non-European operations are not subject to the REACH authorization requirement.
