## MARKING: 5.

- Howmet requires the supplier to include the following information into the Shipping Mark on the goods package. If any item is received without the following required package marking, that item will be considered non-conforming and may be returned to supplier at supplier's expense. Exception should get the email approval of the above import compliance SPA.
  - Country of Origin
  - **Product Description**
  - Specification
  - Quantity
- 6. CERTIFICATIONS: Vendor agrees to provide Howmet with certificates of product, Certificate of Country of Origin, or other written declarations/statements upon request that Howmet may require in order to ensure compliance with all import/export requirements, and secure preferential tariff treatment for Howmet-produced, Howmet-procured and/or Howmet shipped merchandise. Such certificates or other written declarations/statements shall only be provided by Vendor once it has been determined by Vendor and Vendor alone that the representations contained in those certificates or other written





declarations/statements are correct and in accordance with all applicable laws and regulations. In the event it is determined by either Howmet, its agents or a representative government agency that such representations are incorrect, then Vendor agrees to indemnify Howmet and hold it harmless against any and all fines, penalties, liquidated damages or other action taken by such government agency against such merchandise.

- 7. ISPM 15 REGULATION-IMPORTS: All commodity imports with wood packaging material (WPM) consisting of pallets & crates entering or transiting China will be compliant with the ISPM 15 treatment & marking standard.
- 8. TSCA: Prior to importation, full written disclosure of all constituents of metal / chemical / oils to be imported except for impurities and by-products and Material Safety Data Sheets (MSDS) on all hazardous materials. Only constituents with a commercial purpose need be disclosed. This includes oil applied to the metal for a specific commercial purpose such as a corrosion inhibitor, a slippage marking inhibitor but does not include normal residual processing oils.
