

SUPPLEMENTAL TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR ORDERS ASSOCIATED WITH U.S. GOVERNMENT CONTRACTS

The FAR and DFARS clauses referenced below are incorporated herein by reference, with the same force and effect as if they were given in full text, and are applicable to the agreement between your organization (“Seller”) and Howmet (the “Contract”). With the acceptance of each order, Seller certifies that Seller is complying with, and will continue to comply with the provisions of this Contract and applicable laws and regulations.

Seller agrees that upon the request of Howmet, Seller will negotiate in good faith with Seller relative to amendments to this Contract to incorporate additional provisions herein or to change provisions hereof, as Howmet may reasonably deem necessary in order to comply with the provisions of the applicable higher tiered government contract to which Howmet is a party or with the provisions of amendments to such contract.

If the date or substance of any of the clauses listed below is different from the date or substance of the clause actually incorporated in the higher tiered government contract to which Howmet is a party, the date or substance of the clause incorporated by said higher tiered government contract shall apply instead.
